An Indoor Air Quality Screening was conducted by Dwight Lucas, SSA Office of Environmental Health and Occupational Safety on January 21, 2009. The study concluded that no follow-up survey was needed. Mr. Lucas did recommend "the building owner should evaluate the ventilation system to insure sufficient outdoor air is introduced into the occupied environment." While there is no indication in the screening report of insufficient outdoor air, I have contacted the GSA Property Manager, Mr. Ron Brison and have asked him to have the lessor evaluate the ventilation system per the final screening report.


SUBJECT: Indoor Air Quality Screening--ACTION

Attached is a copy of the indoor air quality screening recorded on a Facility Assessment Checklist (FAC). The screening was completed on-site by the Public Health Service on January 21, 2009 for the Shawnee Field Office located at 909 East Federal Street, Shawnee, OK (SSA#796).

The screening was conducted for this facility as part of our nationwide Indoor Air Quality program. Based on our review of the FAC we have concluded that a follow-up survey is not warranted at this time. However, the building owner should evaluate the ventilation system to insure sufficient outdoor air is introduced into the occupied environment.
