By this letter, AFGE Local 2505 files its third Section 10 grievance on the actions of Ada, OK DM Vicky Jackson.

On August 15, DM Jackson sent an e-mail to the Union offering to hear the Union's oral presentation on its first Section 10 at either 8 AM or after 4 PM. (Attached)

So doing is a violation of Article 24, Section 4.D.

SSA has also violated Article 24, Section 1.

Ada DM Jackson's has failed and refused to set a time and date certain for the Union's oral presentation.

Ada Social Security Office. I can make every effort to try to be available on Friday, August 17th at 1:30, however, as I have explained previously we still have the public to see as they come into our office, telephones to answer and appointments that must be taken by the Claims Representatives.

Ada DM Jackson's failure and refusal to set a time and date certain for the Union's oral presentation and SSA's purposeful and willful assignment of her as its representative, knowing full well that she does not have the time nor will carve the time out of her SSA work to hear the Union's presentation, violates Article 24, Section 1 by undermining, frustrating and nullifying the parties' expressed, written desire to "provide a mutually acceptable method for the PROMPT and equitable settlement of grievances..." (EMPHASIS ADDED)
