Dear Regional Commissioner Schuenemeyer:

By this letter, AFGE Local 2505 files an Article 24, Section 10 Union-Management Grievance.

On or about July 26, 2007, AFGE Local 2505 2nd Vice President was informed that Ada, OK SSA District Manager Vicky Jackson announced and implemented a new leave policy. DM Jackson said that SSA will NOT approve leave for Ada employees unless they have a replacement to cover their duties.

The Union was given neither advanced notice nor the opportunity to negotiate over this new policy.

This new policy violates Articles 1, 2, 3, 4 and 31 of the AFGE National Agreement.

The Union requests an oral presentation on this grievance.

I believe it would be beneficial for us to hold the oral presentation in Ada so we could talk to the employees about the pressure they feel, about their stress and anxiety over DM Jackson's micromanagement, her bad attitude, her inability to address them respectfully and treat them like the hard workers that they are. I propose we do this on August 17, in Ada.

The remedy sought by the Union is rescission of the new policy and a return to the *status quo ante*.

Additionally, the Union requests that the employee counseling service go to the Ada Office with a "sick office" and stress program.
